Dressage: USDF Introductory Test B - walk/trot.
Cross-Country: Maximum 2'; Not timed.
Stadium: Maximum 2'

Dressage: USEF 2010 Beginner Novice Test A – Small Arena
Cross-Country: 2' – 2'6"; Speed 350 meters/min.
Stadium: Maximum 2'6"

Novice Rider

Open Novice

Dressage: : USEF 2010 Novice Test A – Small Arena
Cross-Country: Maximum 2'11"; Speed 350 meters/min.
Stadium: Maximum 2'11"

Entry fees: \$125. Make checks payable to Spring Run Stables, Inc. and mail to address above.

Awards: Trophy and eight ribbons per division.

Stabling: OFF GROUNDS (within a few miles); \$25 per night.

Arenas: Sand arenas. Dressage may be held in the indoor arena.
